Rob's Bit

I joined the Pomona auxiliary Fire Brigade in May 1979 at the time the Noosa and Hinterland Fire Brigades were going through an upgrade phase.

The first permanent fireman appointed to the area was Bob Eldridge. One of his duties was to go around the brigades to train the men. Bob's base was the fire station across the Donnella Bridge on the water front at Tewantin. The other stations were Cooroy and Pomona.

It was decided to build the new you beaut station up at The Junction in Noosa. Two councillors, who were farmers from Cooran, didn't approve the plans for the new building. I remember Bob saying, "What would a farmer know about building a Fire Station?" Guess what? For years the roof leaked like a sieve and the government spent hundreds of thousands of dollars fixing the mistakes when the station was built.

Vehicles at the time and pride of the fleet - the 1970 Limited Dodge with Chrysler V8 petrol engine which belongs to the Noosa museum at Pomona and arrived back May 2012. At the Tewantin Station was an 11/2 ton Willies four wheel drive. Cooroy had a Ford F250 with a six cylinder petrol engine which is now used by Boreen Point Bush Fire Brigade. In Pomona we had a 1955 J series Bedford four wheel drive, windscreen, no cab. We also had an 11/2 ton Willies four wheel drive. The SES still have one of these; the other one is in the museum at Strathpine. After the new Noosa station was built they received two new ACCO International fire engines, V8 petrol, fully enclosed

crew cab. Pomona got the Dodge, the Bedford went to the old Tewantin Station. A chap by the name of Adrian cared for her.

We went to many jobs with the Dodge. If there was a training night down at The Junction, we would drive the Dodge down and back with a full tank of water, 300 gallons, just as a taxi. Of course, if there was a call out we would just go.

We almost lost a fireman one time to serious injury. We left the station early in the morning heading out to the highway to a semi roll-over. The Dodge could fit under the railway underpass, however the radio aerial could suffer damage so whoever was in the crew seat would reach up to fold the aerial down. Bruce got up to put the aerial into the operating position as we drive around a sharp right turn and fell out onto the bitumen. We alerted the ambulance and continued out to the job leaving someone with the seriously injured Bruce.

For years the powers to be stayed with petrol powered fire engines. The reason being, on cold winter nights a petrol engine would start up and get going quicker than a diesel. Diesels back in the sixties were quite sluggish but the Japanese engines put a stop to that. Petrol engines are risky in very hot conditions, the liquid turns to a vapour and you don't go anywhere. Before I left the Pomona Brigade, Noosa received a late nineties Mitsubishi, the first diesel fire engine. One night we got called to a house fire out at Skyrings Creek. Away in the Dodge we went. The weather was quite wet down across the creek and up to the fire, but we had no dramas. The permanents came up from Noosa in the Mitsubishi diesel. They became bogged before they crossed the creek.
