In December 1998 the Combined Coastal Car Club hosted the 14th FX-FJ Holden Nationals. It was a huge event for a small club to organise but the success is still enthused about by those who attended. Pause for a minute to think about the enormity of organising a national event in 1998 – computers and email were things big businesses used, laptops and tablets weren't around, mobile phones were the size of bricks, there was no social media. Registrations were taken by mail and cheque, correspondence was by telephone and letters delivered by Australia Post. Imagine the effort!

Bonds and long-term relationships were formed between participants and early club members with some still in contact today. Susanne and Barry have letters written on beautiful hand-made paper expressing thanks to the club for its hospitality and for a well-organised, friendly, professionally run event.

At the end of the 1998 event promotional material was auctioned to raise funds for the 15th FX-FJ Holden Nationals. Travis Adams was the successful bidder for an advertising sandwich board which he claims cost enough to fully fund the next event.

At the March Monthly Club Meeting Travis kindly donated the sandwich board to the Club. Thanks to Travis – the board will be added to the Club's memorabilia.

- Treasurers Report** A report on the expenses and income for February 2019 was provided by the Treasurer. Bank statement was not available for Bank Reconciliation. **Moved** Ian Skipworth and **Seconded** Darryl Nielsen that the Treasurer's report is received and accounts paid **Carried**

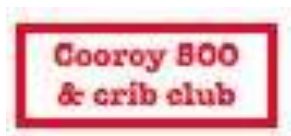
