Chrysler on The Murray 17,18,19 March 2023

Hosted by the *Albury Wodonga Chrysler Club* the event has grown from a small display of 60 cars in 1992 to the largest annual Chrysler show in the Southern hemisphere. **2023 had a record 954 entrant registrations!!!** All Chryslers!

Friday kicked off with the adrenalin events at the *Logic Centre DECA* track, followed by the *Great Reveal* for newly completed vehicles, and early check-in / scrutineering at Gateway Lakes. Hovell Street had all the entertainment on the Friday and Saturday nights. Crowds gathered with their Eskies from mid-afternoon to secure the best position. As soon as the sun set, classics of **all** makes and models hit the street and paraded up and down amongst the regular traffic. Definitely an interesting sight and **the** place to be seen! We made it half way around the Show & Shine on Saturday morning before heading out to Tabletop Hotel (formerly Ettamogah Pub) for the annual photo shoot. Everyone was up early Sunday morning to do it all again. By lunchtime we had covered the other half of the show and had been around the swap sites several times "just in case" something had been missed. Trophy presentations wrapped up 2023 COTM. For the Chrysler buffs – fabulous to see *Moonraker*. The afternoon was perfect for a sight-seeing cruise and chilling out with a decent coffee before preparing for the trip home on Monday.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On 1st September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. **Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).** Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.
