


Hosted by the Albury Wodonga Chrysler Club the event has grown from a small display of 60 cars in 1992 to the largest




Moonraker. The afternoon was perfect for a sight-seeing cruise and chilling out with a decent coffee before preparing for the trip home on Monday.

#### \*\*IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. *Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).* Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.




