Minutes of meeting 5 November 2018

Combined Coastal Car Club Meeting Held on Monday 3 December 2018

- Meeting Opened** Cliff Watson opened the meeting at 7.17pm
- Apologies** John Waters, Dave Anderson.
- New Members** Nil
- Visitors** Little John
- Previous Minutes** as in November magazine
- Treasurers Report** A report on the expenses for October 2018 was provided by the Treasurer which included the income and expenditure relating to the Car Show & Shine. **Moved** Bea Nielsen and **Seconded** Steve Smith that the Treasurer's report is received and accounts paid **Carried** November Treasurer's Report not presented. Bank statement not available for reconciliation.
- Correspondence** **Incoming:** Usual magazines; Statements IGA, CBA; a member of the public advised of their 1978 HZ Statesman for sale; Return to Sender of Newsletter to Lee McInnes; email from QHMC re Judging procedures used by Sydney Council of Motor Clubs; email from Paul and Jane Hansen regarding their application for club membership; advice of Not for Profit Group – assistance for Clubs such as ours; email from Katie Rose Cottage advising all volunteers are covered by insurance while at the Club House; EOI from Noosa Council for 10 hours of free one-on-one tailored strategic planning sessions; Noosa Council Cooroy Sports meeting agenda for 21 November meeting; Minutes from that Meeting; receipt for renewal and payment for QHMC affiliation; email from AEHF regarding upcoming FX-FJ Nationals at Murray Bridge SA; reply from JK Plumbing advising that they no longer erect guttering; thank you email from Noosa Electrical for advising them of not gaining a grant; email from OTIUM Planning advising that they had been engaged by Noosa Council to review and update the master plans for Noosa District and Cooroy Sports Complex; email from Townsville Veteran, Vintage & Historic Motor Club [re survey for SIVS registration changes](#); email from QHMC & TMR regarding impromptu events; email from Christine Borg enquiring about membership to club; letter from Orange Sky Laundry seeking a donation of \$500; AGL Electricity account; Invoice and documents from AIS for contents insurance renewal.

- Moved** Travis Adams **Seconded** Jenny Cowley that the Incoming and Outgoing correspondence be accepted **Carried**
- Business Arising** Kym Anderson outlined the plans for the Christmas party; Cliff spoke about the good role up of vehicles for the Christmas in Cooroy street parade; Life Flight forwarded a letter advising that they had made \$542.20 at their stall on the Car Show day and thanked the Club for the opportunity.

Minutes of meeting 5 November 2018 (Continued)

General Business The meeting was advised of the passing of former member Dave Chambers. Dave and his family were active, respected members of the Club before Dave and Jo retired and moved north. Dave & Jo were Club Members of the Year in 2003, Dave was Vice-president in 2008 and President in 2009. Members are invited to attend a Memorial Service to celebrate Dave's life on Saturday 19th January 2019 at Bell Park, Emu Park near Rockhampton. Dave's family has asked that donations be made to the Cancer Council of Queensland in lieu of flowers. The meeting agreed that \$50 will be donated. It is noted that Darryl and Bea Nielsen are attending the service and will be driving their sedan club car; Regarding the project by the Noosa Council to review and update the master plans for Noosa District and Cooroy Sports Complex, Members were asked to provide input about what plans the Club may have for the future 5 to 10 years eg increase in membership numbers, more events on the field, parking etc;

2010 Dave - Club Member of the Year AGM in February - nomination forms for all positions are available in "All Torque" newsletter, on the website or from current committee. Cliff asked Members present to consider nominating for a position; Alan Springate expressed a wish for secret ballots for management committee positions at the February AGM out of respect for members. Ian Skipworth advised that Section 13(f) "Procedure at a General Meeting" of the Club Constitution states that, (if problems occur president or chairperson can call a secret ballot). Following a short discussion Alan Springate **Moved** and Darryl Nielsen **Seconded** that should there be more than one person nominated for the positions of President, Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer, then a Secret Ballot will be called. **Carried**; Kym Anderson advised that at the last AGM, a motion was carried that the accounts need not be audited. Kym further advised that as this year's financial revenue is above \$20,000, the club is now classified as Level 2 by the Office of Fair Trading and must have the financial statements audited or verified. The meeting agreed to again engage Simon Levett to conduct the audit and incur the expense of the auditing fees; Kym advised that contents insurance is due again and has received a quote of \$906 from AIS Insurance Brokers along with 4 other quotes for comparison. Kym was asked to check with Shannons' Insurance to see if they could better the price. Members agreed to paying the current insurance invoice if no better quote was obtained; Kym has received a price of approximately \$521.48 for general public liability insurance from AIS. Current public liability insurer Arthur J Gallagher will be asked to provide a quote. QHMC has been contacted about what insurance may be available under affiliation. Members agreed for committee to accept the most appropriate public insurance coverage. Jenny and Rob Cowley spoke about recently attending the Just Eights Club Show & Shine. John Colwell and Scott Jones also attended. They were presented with the Best Represented Car Club trophy. This followed on from the one they brought back from Bundaberg, Jenny also showed off the two page spread in the Sunshine Coast News with a number of photos of Marilyn; Kym showed the photo of the Charger in the Cooroy Rag Christmas in Cooroy article; as mentioned in Incoming Correspondence, the club has received correspondence from the Townsville Veteran, Vintage & Historic Motor Club which is conducting a survey of over 300 motoring clubs throughout Queensland to determine whether the present SIVS registration needs to be changed to suit the needs of the many motoring enthusiasts in this State. Rob Cowley **Moved** and Steve Smith **Seconded** that the questionnaire

be answered **Carried**. Rob Cowley offered to complete the form; Rob Jeffs thanked the Club for the Sympathy card he received following the passing of his Wife.

Darryl Nielsen spoke about the November Club Run to Kandanga for mornos and then onto Borumba Dam for lunch. It was a fine day and a good role up of club cars. The Fish and Chip night at the Pomona Hotel was very well attended also. Jackie arranged a game of Trivia which got everyone putting their thinking caps on. 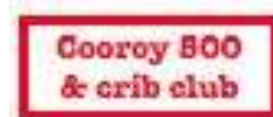
