Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego). Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.

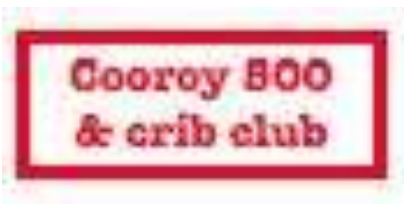
