President

Chairs the committee, plays a major role in general meetings, maintains relationships with committee, members, and external organisations. Positively represents the club external forums & meetings. Promotes the club.

Vice-President

Stands in when the president is not available. Assists the President and other committee positions.

Secretary

Is the general administrator of the club. **Note:** should be able to use, or learn to use, email, *Word* & other software

- sends and receives correspondence and other documents; keeps document records
- takes nominations for committee
- manages all aspects of meetings
- keeps a register of members (assisted by the Treasurer)

Treasurer

Is the financial administrator of the Club. Club runs combination of manual/electronic records (spreadsheet).

- maintains financial records
- prepares and presents monthly cashbook & bank reconciliation
- administration of finances for events eg Car Show, Field Day
- assists Secretary keep register of members

Dating Officer

Sign-off *Historic Dating & Membership Certificate* in line with Dept Qld TMR, QHMC, and club guidelines

Club Run Coordinator

Liaise with committee and members to identify and organise club runs. May include Sunday Cruises, dinners, other car shows and events – any event members can take their car for a run. Attends and takes the lead when possible.

Car Show Coordinator

Liaise with committee, members, and external parties to organise annual Cooroy Car Show. A group of members can be pulled together to help organise. Guide being added to each year. Many arrangements for 2022 in place.

Newsletter Editor

Liaise with Secretary, committee, and members to produce monthly "*All Torque*" newsletter. Club is required to distribute a newsletter which contains meeting minutes and club runs. Must be software/technologically savvy.

Webmaster

Maintain Club's website and Facebook page. Must be software/social media/technologically savvy.

Merchandise Coordinator

Liaise with committee and members to organise Club merchandising. Place orders and issue receipts to members. Supplier in place for shirts.

QHMC Delegate (Qld Historic Motoring Council)

Raise and feedback information between QHMC & members (eg changes to concessional registration). QHMC - overarching organisation for historical motoring in Qld; meetings held monthly in Brisbane; regional delegates don't attend; QHMC working to make Zoom style technology available. Information obtained from minutes.

Catering Coordinator

Organises food for club events eg working bees. May be asked assist organise vendors for Car Show & other events.

On 1st September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. Financial membership of an incorporated car club **must** be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC rego (club rego).

Remaining on club rego while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000 and result in insurances being voided.

Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC rego to standard rego.

Secretary's Report: This information on seat belts was in the QHMC number 15 newsletter.

INFORMATION Seat Belts At our October meeting a question on seat belts was raised by a Delegate re the Government camera system introduced to take photos of seat belts not being used and mobile phones being used. These misdemeanours would incur a hefty fine and loss of points. Cars prior to 1969 in Australia did not have seat belts fitted when manufactured. This means a number of our classic and historic cars did not have seat belts fitted. On talking with a representative from Transport and Main Roads (TMR) he stated that all photos taken are cross referenced with the vehicles registration details and if the vehicle is prior to 1969 and no belts were fitted no further action would occur – the photo would be dismissed. However he did say if a photo was inadvertently processed and a summons was issued contact TMR and they will deal with it in your favour. Please let QHMC know if you do encounter a problem and we will contact TMR on your behalf.
