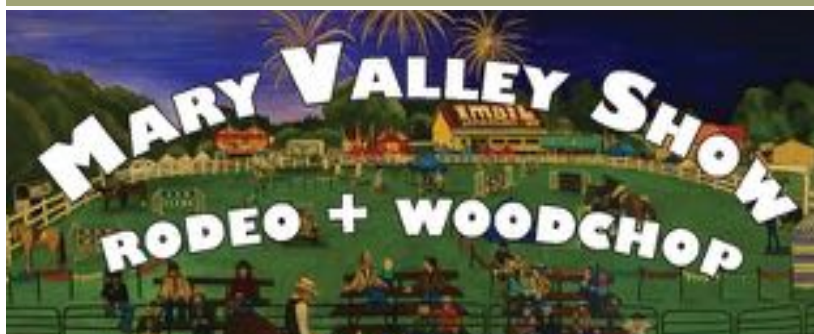

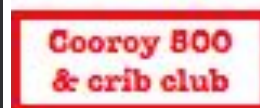

ROB'S BIT

"ANZAC Day 2016"



The Gympie community once again supported their ANZACs in force. I have been taking part in the parades for quite a few years but was fortunate not to have had to get involved in any of the conflicts.

During my school years the Korean conflict was in progress and I used to see the Army training at Tewantin and Sunrise Beach. By the time of the Vietnam conflict I was, luckily, too old to sign up or be conscripted. So the least I can do is to support the veterans with my vehicle from yesteryear.



For several years I've been a friend to Graham Weis who fought in the Korean War. He wasn't, by any means, a small man, but he was able to squeeze into the front of the Dodge. The grandchildren used to come too.

When my uncle Jack Waldoch got too old to march in the parades I decided to take him each year. He enlisted for WWII in Cooroy in 1942, two years before I was born; and at 96 he's still going, living independently and doing his own shopping.

Although I first drove the Dodge in the Cooroy parade, since then I've taken it to Gympie, where Uncle Jack lives in Hilton Rd.

In the beginning I went to the Cooroy ANZAC day parade with Alan Kenzler, Rod Dries, Reg Wilkie, Sue Poetter and Vic Toonan. Prominent ladies from Cooroy such as Una Bryant and Joan Boyce have been passengers in the Dodge.

(They have yet to travel in my 2009 Kia Rio – Editor)
