- Treasurers Report** A report on the income and expenditure for the month of May 2018 was **read** by Kym Anderson. It was **Moved** by Rob Cowley and **Seconded** by Jenny Cowley that the Treasurers report is received and accounts paid. **Carried.**

Mary River Road Bridge Closure



Project news

13th June 2018

Mary River Road Bridge Replacement - Cooroy

Project summary

Council's commitment to safer travelling experiences will see contractors commence work soon on a new concrete bridge with a 100-year life span, in Mary River Road, Cooroy.

Funding

Council has allocated \$2.1m, which includes funding from the Australian Government Bridges Renewal Program to construct the bridge.

Project Scope

The design of the bridge will provide improved access to the Cooroy township with:

- two vehicle lanes
- dedicated cycle lanes
- off road shared pathway
- removing the current load limit

Duration of work

Work will commence on Monday 2nd July 2018 with completion expected in November 2018, weather dependent.

Traffic management and safety

Mary River Road will be closed between Marara Street and Lower Mill Road for the duration of the project.

Detours will be in place for traffic and pedestrians (detour map overleaf):

- Vehicles - via Garnet Street and Sportsground Parade
- Pedestrians - via Mill Place and Lower Mill Road or through Apex Park.

Signage will be in place prior and during the work to inform the public.
