Queensland Historic Motoring Council

QHMC is the peak body for historic motoring clubs in Qld. It represents its member clubs in negotiations with government departments, interstate peak motoring bodies and commercial/public bodies. It currently

Represents 93 affiliated clubs with a total of 13,337 members with 18,179 vehicles.

“Report on Alternative and Legacy Fuels (AALF) – Electric Vehicles. At the QHMC April meeting a committee was formed to deal with issues arising from both the potential long term reduction of access to fossil fuels and to research and present reliable information on the current state of play regarding hybrid and electric vehicles and batteries and other alternative fuel and energy sources used in vehicles.”

A survey is being sent to clubs to:

- find out any concerns members have about getting fossil fuel for their cars in the future
- research and present reliable information about hybrid and electric vehicles, batteries, and other alternative fuel/energy sources for vehicles.

The survey results will be collated, sent to members, and included in the committee's research. Combined Coastal Car Club will send the survey to members by email.

If you want to have a say about fuel for your cars in the future, and consequently the future of historic vehicles, car clubs, and club rego, please complete the survey by 30th August 2022.

AHMF Robert Shannon Foundation

Do you know a young person or group of young people under the age of 30 years actively working on historic vehicles or engaged in studying automotive restoration and preservation?

They may be eligible for a grant from the Robert Shannon Foundation.

The Australian Historic Motoring Federation is the national body representing classic and historic vehicle clubs in all states and territories. The AHMF established the Robert Shannon Foundation in 2003 to perpetuate the memory of Robert Shannon, founder of Shannons Insurance, who died unexpectedly in March 2000. Robert was an avid classic car enthusiast, who especially enjoyed his 1930 Invicta S Type. He was a strong supporter of the historic motoring movement and was concerned that it was not attracting enough younger people, particularly in the areas of the preservation and restoration of classic vehicles.

The purpose of the Foundation is to encourage people under the age of 30 to become involved in the restoration and preservation of veteran, vintage, post-vintage, historic 50's, historic 60's, historic 70's and historic 80's vehicles up to 30 years old.

Applicants must be supported by an affiliated club such as the Combined Coastal Car Club.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On 1st September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. **Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).** Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.

Here’s some interesting motoring facts for July

July 3, 1886 Invention of the Automobile - Karl Benz unveiled his invention the first gasoline-powered auto to the world in Mannheim, Germany.

July 5, 1865 Locomotive Acts Enacted in Britain – commonly known as the Red Flag Act, this Act restricted automobile speed to a maximum of 4 MPH. This law actually required someone to walk ahead of the vehicle with a red flag or lantern for safety.

July 16, 1935 Birth of the Parking Meter - much to the dismay of drivers everywhere, the first parking meter was installed in Oklahoma City, invented by Carl C. Magee.

July 21, 1904 First Car to Top 100 mph - in Ostend, Belgium, Lous Rigolly achieved a speed of nearly 104 mph, becoming the first person to drive a car over 100 mph.

July 23 1903 First Ford Car Sold - the Model A was sold to Dr. Ernst Pfenning of Chicago, Illinois.

July 24, 1910 Alfa Romeo Founded - A.L.F.A. (Anonima Lombarda Fabbrica Automobili) was founded in Milan, Italy. By 1920, the company would officially be known as Alfa Romeo.

July 31, 1928 Chrysler Acquires Dodge Brothers - for a staggering \$170 million!
