Thanks to RDA for organising the morning and recognising our contribution to their vital work.






Head under the bonnet of his car, a certain club member reaches blindly for his water bottle but grabs the bottle of brake fluid by mistake.


Minutes of last meeting 4th April 2016 (continued)

The Love Bug movie premiered in 1969 and I remember watching it on the Sunday night "Wonderful world of Disney" TV program in the mid-70s. The cheeky, full-of-personality car Herbie fuelled an early love for VW beetles.

Herbie #2 (in the pic above right) was the only Porsche-powered Herbie. He originally had a super-90 engine; and also had upgrades of Porsche drum brakes, Koni shock absorbers and Superior Control Arms, which strengthened the rear.

Although many beetles were used, ranging from 1950s to 1970s models, all were modified to look like the 1963 bug.

In order to create the effect of Herbie driving himself, Disney concocted a detailed system of sprockets and pulleys connected to a second steering column under the front seat for a rear seat driver.

There was also a second set of pedal assemblies, clutch cables and a shifter extension. In *The Love Bug*, the rear seat driver sat low enough to see over the windshield but still out of the view of the camera.

The Herbie in the pic to the right was specially modified with a high performance 1835 cc engine so it could do those wheelies!

Oh and in case you're

wondering what happened to all those VW beetles used in filming, one recently sold for US\$126,000 (about AU\$174,000.) Which, coincidentally, is the current asking price of my 2009 Kia Rio.
