Minutes of extraordinary meeting 14th May 2018

Meeting Opened

Cliff Watson opened the meeting at 7.05pm

Apologies Col McKie, Jenny and Rob Cowley, Andy Cohen, Rob Epps, Shirley Wilde, Leon Fleming

Business

Cliff advised that the extraordinary meeting was called to discuss the EOI currently being advertised by the Noosa Council for the future management of the Cooroy RV Stopover.

Discussion at the meeting of 7 May 2018 ranged from possible source of income to loss of use of our property, so it was decided it was important to take the time to discuss the matter fully at a dedicated meeting.

Council is seeking a not-for-profit organisation to manager the RV Stopover commencing on 1 July 2018. The EOI closes at 2:00pm on Tuesday 22 May.

Kym set up a projector connected to her lap-top to enable all present to view the relevant Council documents being three of eg; Invitation for EOI, Part 6 EOI Response Form and Draft Freehold Permit.

Brent and Kevin were thanked for reading the EOI documentation and invited to contribute to the briefing.

Members were invited to contribute to the discussion and ask questions.

Kym expanded on what mandatory information is to be outlined and demonstrated by an applicant in the Response Form to Council.

Kym advised the meeting of her thoughts on a forecast of income and expenditure balance sheet going on known costs and income.

Kym also outlined the potential Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) for the Club if it took on the management of the RV Stopover.

The main issues that came out of the information tabled were there was: limited time to complete a Response Form; potential drop in numbers of campers due to other facilities opening up in the area; no one in the Club having the time to devote a minimum of 10 hours a week to oversee the management; the management of dispute resolution issues that will arise from time to time; lack of resources, finances and people power to manage the RV Stopover; potential financial loss.

Members also made it clear they felt the club: should focus on being a car club and related activities; needs to reestablish the spirit and fun within the club; faced losing more members if the focus on the RV Stopover continued.

Also, it is very likely that our Constitution does not cover such a venture.

Cliff stated that he has knowledge of at least a dozen local groups interested in submitting an application.

Following Kym's presentation and member discussion, it was decided to have a formal Motion put to the floor for all attendees to vote on.

Darryl Nielsen **Moved and** Bea Nielsen **Seconded** that: The club not submit an EOI for the management of the RV Stopover. The club focus on its core objective of being a car club. The club work proactively and positively with the new management organisation of the RV Stopover to create a positive relationship. **Carried**

Conclusion: Kym was thanked by everyone present for her work researching costs and issues prior to the meeting and the presentation during the meeting. The meeting was very open and forthright with members making valuable contributions to the discussion and frankly expressing their views. **Meeting closed 8:45**
