### Sommerset Dam BBQ and PICNIC

This central location will allow multi club members located either on the North side or South side to meet and proceed to the venue individually or in convoy. The meeting points are:

or
- United Petrol Station, Johnson Rd, Forest Dale.

Members and guests are requested to all meet at Spit Lake Park between **11:00-11:30.**

You can enjoy a BYO lunch (council BBQ's are available) and bring some chairs for a relaxing picnic. Also, a regular coffee van is on site at the park.

#### North-side Route:

Meeting at the BP Truck-stop north bound, Bruce Hwy ,Caboolture. Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> of July at 9:30am for a 9:45am departure.

Leaving the BP and heading north on the Bruce Hwy and then taking the D'Águilar Hwy Kilcoy Exit, then following the D'Águilar Hwy to Woodford. Just past Woodford take Neurum Rd on your left to Villeneuve, follow this until it meets back up to the D'Águilar Hwy turning left to Kilcoy. Following the signs through Kilcoy to Esk route 85 and then left at Esk-Kilcoy Rd to Somerset Dam. Then, keep a eye out for the sign that reads The Spit 400m ( about 20k's along Esk-Kilcoy Rd, and then take the exit off to the left to the The Spit Lake Park. Upon entering the park through the main gates take the first road to your right up to the parking area. Here you will find a stop to park up and set up away from the boat ramp.

#### South-side Route:

Meeting at the United Petrol Station,466-486 Johnson Rd, Forest Dale.Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> of July at 9:30am for a 9:45am departure.

Leaving the Service Station and turning left onto Johnson Rd and then right at Cobalt St and then left onto Mica St (following the sign to Camira). At the roundabout, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto the M2 ramp to Ipswich. Following the M2 to the Esk/South Burnett exit A17 follow A17 to Wivenhoe /Somerset Rd turning right then right at Esk/Kilcoy Rd to Somerset Dam. Then turn right into The Spit ( look for the blue sign), Upon entering the park through the main gates take the first road to your right up to the parking area. Here you will find a stop to park up and set up away from the boat ramp.

On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. **Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).** Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.

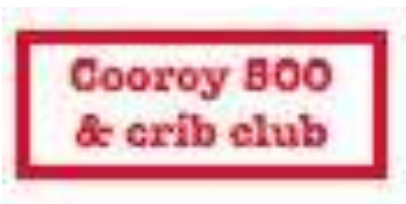
