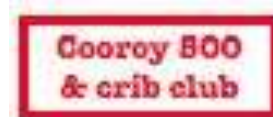

Rob's Bit

I am pleased with my Jeep, it is quite neat and reliable.

It has been in two ANZAC parades already.

Don't think I am sitting at home waiting to die. I have been flat out with a 1934 Ford two ton truck.

The vehicle has a lot of history. It was used by F.A.Rows to deliver groceries around Cooroy. Not only did it travel around Cooroy but also outlying roads west of Cooroy, Ridgewood, Lawnville and Tinbeerwah.

Arthur Spickett remembers having a ride in the truck. Rows use to go around collecting grocery orders on horseback. One day the normal horse had something wrong with it so he decided to use Arthur's horse which he rode into Cooroy then he had a trip home in the Ford truck.

Unique features of the truck are semi elliptical cross springs in the front radius rods, enclosed drive shaft with one universal mechanical brakes and side valve V8 engine.

I will always be indebted to Jim and Richie Thomas for finding a radiator and motor.

In 1949 Rows traded in the old girl and invested in a brand new truck.

The 34 took on a different role at Ringtail Creek, carting bees and pineapples for Jack Guard all these years and the truck will be going once more.
