## 2020 AGM

### **Secretary**

- Sends and receives letters, emails or other documents (via Australia Post and the Club's Admin email)
- Files and manages correspondence and documents
- Calls meetings, prepares agenda and takes minutes for the Club's monthly meeting. Prepares minutes for distribution
- Completes and sends the Annual Report to Office of Fair Trading following the AGM
- Works closely with other committee members
- Is a co-signatory on the club's bank account
- May attend meetings with the Cooroy Sporting Complex, Cooroy Chamber of Commerce and/or Noosa Council
- Ensures the club operates in line with its objectives, the constitution and legislation  
Keeps the register of members (along with the Treasurer).

### **Car Show Co-ordinator**

- Oversees the organisation, running and wind-up of the annual Cooroy Car Show
- Is point of contact for the show
- Works closely with club committee and members
- Along with committee ensures the car show operates within legislation and insurance requirements
- Responds to enquiries and expressions of interest through email, Facebook and phone.
- Ensures the show is promoted
