F100 Project Update

This page is normally reserved for the member profile, unfortunately I ran out of time this month so decided to update you on my F100 project instead. So far I've replaced the rear brakes, removed the tool box and spare tire rack from the tray and started assessing the bodywork.

There's A LOT of rust! The more I dig, the more rust I find. I think I will be spending many hours grinding, welding and sanding over the coming months.

The rear brake cylinders were seized and the rest of the brake parts were rusty or generally in poor condition so I replaced the lot, drums, shoes, cylinders, springs and hand brake cables. *Note the before and after pictures above are different sides.*



The tool box and spare tire rack (seen above) are now gone. I just need to remove the LPG tank to fully reveal the timber decking on the tray. I think this will look nice after a sand and varnish! To the right you can see just some of the rust I've uncovered so far.

Apart from removing the LPG tank, the next job on my list is to replace the front wheel bearings and uni joints so I can refit the front drive shaft and get the 4WD working again.

I will keep you posted in future newsletters. Rob.
