### Qld Department of Transport Agrees to Impromptu Events

In December 2018 the Queensland Historic Motoring Council notified affiliated clubs that the Queensland Department of Transport & Main Roads had agreed to Impromptu Events being introduced and included in the conditions of the Special Interest Vehicle Concession Scheme (commonly called club rego). This is in lieu of introducing an onerous log-book system.

The Queensland Department of Transport recently updated its website to reflect these changes. The choice to adopt Impromptu Events, then implement and administer them was left to clubs. At the April CCCC Monthly Meeting members discussed whether Impromptu Events was something they wanted and how it could be fairly administered within the Club. This is recorded in the monthly meeting minutes. More details about how an Impromptu Event can be requested by CCCC members, submitted and sanctioned by the Club will be issued to members soon.

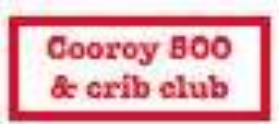
