#### QHMC Feedback

Concessional Registration Usage – BE AWARE!! Police are conducting regular checks to ensure vehicles are being used within SIVC registration guidelines. Member's responsibility to ensure financial membership & carry correct paperwork. Be aware that not all advertised events meet SIVC guidelines and may need to be sanctioned by the club. Check-out SIVC guidelines on TMR website.

1. Operating Heritage Australia – an informal association of major organisations has been formed. Working to improve recognition and support for all types of operating moveable heritage.
  2. TMR has established a review of current Qld vehicle modification standards with a view to having some alignment with other states
  3. TMR rules covering modifications in the fitting of electric motors to classic, veteran, and vintage vehicles covered in NCoP VSB14 on TMR website. Look-up if you are considering modifications.
  4. TMR has been undertaking review of Qld existing written-off vehicle scheme. Commenced due to recent parliamentary transport & resources committee enquiry. Will cover quality of repair, NSW written-off vehicle scheme, inter-state movement of written-off vehicles. Will explore all aspects and propose future Qld model.  
Export Restrictions – export of some historic vehicles could be prohibited under *Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Act 1986 & Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage Regulations 2018*. Check out [www.arts.gov.au](http://www.arts.gov.au) for a list of items whose export has been blocked & for further info.
1. TMR has clarified what documents need to be provided when applying for SIVC rego. Includes evidence of current membership with incorporated vehicle club or association & must be:
    - a. On club letterhead
    - b. Include details of the vehicle/s (make, model, year, chassis no etc)
    - c. Be signed by club official  
Match the name of the recorded registered operator

TMR will keep **copy** of club letter. Member keeps originals. Club is not required to keep copies under TMR policy. As an incorporated club, there is a requirement for accurate record keeping. The club asks members to provide details of vehicles on club rego.

## National Motor Museum

**Did you know the Australian National Motor Museum houses the George Brooks Library and Learning Centre which is one of the world's most significant motoring libraries?**

The century old stone mill building of the Museum holds more than just memories of its days as a bustline flour mill. It is now a library of approximately 11,000 books and 40,000 magazines on motoring. The books and manuals provide reference material for most makes of cars and include parts catalogues, repair guides, tool catalogues, sales brochures, motoring fiction, travelogues, historical reference books, owners manuals, instruction books, mechanical engineering books, restoration guides, automobile encyclopaedias and registration details.



In addition, there are large collections of periodicals ranging from weekly motoring and trade journals to popular monthly magazines. These cover an extensive range of topics from sales and marketing to technical and trade magazines. The magazines are predominantly Australia but there is also a collection of British and American periodicals. Many of the magazines are rare, some dating back over a century.

The Library also holds posters, sales brochures, VCRs, DVDs, 16 mm and 35 mm cine films and thousands of photographs and negatives.

### \*\*IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On 1<sup>st</sup> September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. **Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).** Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.
