




My favourite thing about that '65 Spitfire was driving it with the top down through Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. They weren't always peaceful drives, though.

In December 1982 I had been at a Christmas Drawing office get together. After leaving with my mate Paul, the Minister for Health's bodyguards surrounded the car in their three new Mercedes. One bodyguard got out and shot at us at a traffic light in the middle of the city of Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. (His rage may or may not have been exacerbated by Paul's having been giving them "forkies".) Some teeth were knocked out of Paul's mouth while we were parked at the lights, so we reported it to the police who recommended that we lay low for a bit.

After that long street chase in my open top sporty, I escaped to the nearby Matopos game reserve and slept there for a few nights under the stars. The incident hit the papers and Alison still has the newspaper cutting in her scrapbook. This all happened when I was just starting out with her and I bet she wondered what she had got herself into!

ROB'S BIT "Restoring a Harley Motorbike"





John Stark and his wife Rozlyn lived most of their lives in Gympie. He went to school in Gympie and grew up there, then moved to Stanthorp to grow Wilson plums. His next venture was in plastics.

Many years later, he was again living in Gympie on a property at Harvey's Siding. In the beginning you turned off at the Pineapple Farm but of course now there are no pineapples – it's all houses.

Being a marriage celebrant was another part of their life as well as lay preacher and an energetic worker at the Gympie Mining Museum at the Duck Pond.

John was one of those who restored the first steam engine 45 for the Mary Valley Rattler. When he was of age, he joined the Army Cadets in Gympie. He didn't actually see army conflict but was trained and readv.





One activity was riding an Army Motorbike. He told me about travelling up the Black Snake Range at Kilkivan.

When he was in his seventies, John thought it would be great if he could find a Harley Davidson like he used to ride. Eventually, he found one on a property in Western Victoria and drove down in his Falcon car with his trailer and son

His next project was to bring it back to new condition. He really enjoyed seeing it all coming together. Rozlyn wouldn't allow him to ride his bike at that age. I was suppose to tow the trailer in the Gympie Anzac Parade with my Jeep but as I still haven't got the Jeep going, another chap did the honours. The Starks now live in a retirement village in Woombye.
