Not all members received emailed invites – being resent.

The new Club Honour Board has been completed and will be unveiled at the 25th anniversary celebration dinner.

**General Business** Cliff spoke about the King of the Mountain and Billy Cart events held in July where there was good attendance by Club Members and their cars; Committee had a short meet and greet with Cooroy Chamber and Commerce Committee at Club House prior to Club meeting; formal meeting to be arranged to discuss common matters; Kym attended the Cooroy Sports Complex Meeting with Mark Borgert of Noosa Council on 1 August and gave a report on matters that was discussed at the meeting; if a Club Member wishes to receive a full set of Minutes from the August meeting please contact Ian Skipworth Secretary; Security Issues issues reported in Noosa although no recent incidents in Cooroy; Mark will follow up on oval drainage & drain/creek slashing; Discussion about measures to avoid private residents using (industrial) bins, padlocks to be installed; Building maintenance & compliance audit raised – being presented to councilors at next council meeting. CCCC Planning with consultant – what does the future look like for us? 5 – 10 year plan; Copy of 2007 Master Plan provided by Mark;

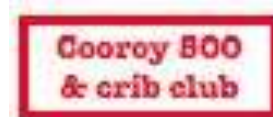
