**IMPORTANT INFORMATION

On 1st September 2021 Qld Dept TMR guidelines for Special Interest Vehicle Concessional registration changed. *Financial membership of an incorporated car club must be maintained year to year to be eligible for Qld SIVC registration (club rego).* Remaining on SIVC registration while not maintaining financial membership of a club may incur fines of over \$4000, your vehicle/s may be considered unregistered, and result in insurances being voided. Owners have 14 days from when their membership lapses to transfer vehicles from SIVC to full registration.

Special Interest Vehicle Concession Scheme Guide

What to carry in your vehicle


"We recommend you carry paperwork that supports your reason for travel. This could include:

- -club newsletter
- -club calendar of events.

If your vehicle is being used and displayed for a funeral event, we understand there may not be enough time to include this as an event on an official club newsletter or calendar of events. In this instance, a funeral notice or an order of service would be suitable to support your reason for travel.

If you use your vehicle outside of the conditions of the special interest vehicle concession, you may face a fine or risk having your concession revoked."

Kym attended on-line workshop about Office of Fair-Trading changes. See appendix for Main Points. Major change for *CCCC* is to OFT financial reporting thresholds. From 1st July 2023:

- Large associations (previously Level 1) changed from current assets or revenue of more than \$100,000 to either (a) current assets of more than \$1 million or (b) total revenue of more than \$500,000
- Medium associations (previously Level 2) changed from current assets or total revenue between \$20,000 & \$100,000 to either (a) current assets between \$300,000 & \$1 million or (b) total revenue between \$150,000 & \$500,000
- **Small associations** (previously Level3) changed from current assets or revenue less than \$20,000 to current assets of less than \$300,000 <u>and</u> total revenue of less than \$150,000.
- Small associations must complete a full audit if association is required to do so under another law, including Collections Act (e.g. fundraising) and Gaming Machine Act (e.g pokies). In all other cases, verification is enough unless members specifically request an audit. President or Treasurer need to verify the financial statements. If satisfied, they will provide this written, signed statement: The association's financial records show the association keeps adequate financial records that correctly record and explain transactions and enable a true and fair financial statement to be prepared.

Moved: that a motion be put to members at a General Meeting on Monday 4th September to consider the Office of Fair Trading changes and remove the requirement for an annual audit of the Club's financial statements.

Kym attended a workshop about Office of Fair-Trading changes. Main points:

- Incorporated Associations Guide has been updated. Available on OFT website
- Any member of the public can obtain a copy of an organisation's rules & OFT documents
- OFT do NOT require a copy of By-laws
- General Meeting requirements must be at least once a year (AGM)
- Management Committee must meet at least once every 4 months
- No requirement under Act or Regs to keep hard-copy records. Digital records acceptable.
- OFT must be advised within 1 month of when a committee position becomes vacant
- Common seal not required since 2022
- Major change for CCCC is to the OFT financial reporting thresholds from 1st July 2023.
 Large associations (previously Level 1) changed from current assets or revenue of more than \$100,000 to either (a) current assets of more than \$1 million or (b) total revenue of more than \$500,000

Medium associations (previously Level 2) changed from current assets or total revenue between \$20,000 and \$100,000 to either (a) current assets between \$300,000 and \$1 million or (b) total revenue between \$150,000 and \$500,000

Small associations (previously Level 3) changed from current assets or revenue less than \$20,000 to current assets of less than \$300,000 <u>and</u> total revenue of less than \$150,000. **Small associations** - must complete a full audit if required to do so under another law, including the Collections Act (e.g., if you fundraise) and Gaming Machine Act (eg pokies)

In all other cases, verification is enough unless members specifically ask for an audit. President or Treasurer will need to verify the financial statements. Motion that in accordance with Office of Fair-Trading changes on 1st July 2023, the Combined Coastal Car Club INC 13076 financial statements be verified by both President <u>and</u> Treasurer, and an auditor no longer be engaged to audit the Club's financial statements unless

- members specifically request an audit due to concerns about the Club's financial management
- the Club is required to do so under another law e.g. (Collections Act 1966)


